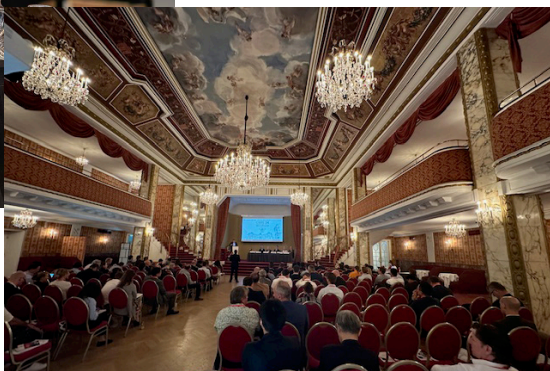

TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP

Since its inception, the CSRS-Europe mission has always been to exchange and develop ideas and philosophies regarding diagnosing and treating cervical spine injury and disease. The Fellowship aims to expose young spine surgeons under 40 years old practising in Europe to other institutions and CSRS-E senior surgeons with expertise in the cervical spine to broaden their experience and foster their academic careers.

Up to 4 fellows per year are selected by the Scientific Research & Education Committee after on-line application on CSRS-E webpage.

Grant: 4 000 Euros* grant supports travel and housing for one travelling fellow to spend time with senior CSRS-Europe members up to 2 weeks (conditions may vary).

RESEARCH GRANT

To facilitate research in the field of the cervical spine, the Cervical Spine Research Society – Europe provides the opportunity to award a Research Grant to fund a research project. Research in all fields related to the cervical spine is eligible for a grant request.

The Scientific Research & Education Committee will decide on the grant adjudication. The annual award chosen for the CSRS-Europe Research Grant will be made at the CSRS-Europe Annual meeting.
